Food Distribution

able to partner with some native missionaries and friends, Alex and Glenda, to distribute some food in a rural community in

La Paz. Alex and Glenda are serving as missionary/interim pastors of a church plant in an area that depends largely on seasonal agricultural

work. With the help of a donation specifically for food provisions, we were able to enable Alex and

Hospitals are maxed out, and there is scarcity of life-saving medications. Recently, some dear

But, due to the lengthy, strenuous recovery they are undergoing, their livelihood from their small business and their mounting medical bills have been an economic concern. We were able to contribute to their medical costs, but we invite you to continue to pray for their needs and ongoing recuperation.
