News from Pastor Henocho Fuentes

Yes, we are almost in 2022 and I wish all of you a very Merry Christmas and a blessed New Year! “May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among Yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus.” (Romans 15:5)

It has been eighteen months since I have sent you a newsletter of what is going on in the ministry of Pastor Henocho Fuentes and an update of my family. I will bring you up to date now. Since Covid-19 started, I have preached 74 sermons in Spanish and 74 in English. I missed only one weekend when I was hospitalized with a stroke. I never got Covid, by the grace of God. On Sunday mornings, we have a 7 a.m. Spanish service that goes throughout Latin America to connect with another ten different ministries online. You can find it mainly on Facebook @Casa Amen. We worship, pray, have a Bible reading, and a sermon. Most of last year, I preached on the Sermon on the Mount. A few weeks ago, I started a series on The Parables of Jesus.

On Friday afternoons, I have been playing live music (mainly accordion) during which time I have covered the whole Christian Life Hymn book. All of this has been done under CASA AMEN (praying the CASA Confession-- Adoration, Supplication, Act of Thanksgiving). AMEN stands for our mission--Action of Mercy Evangelizing Nations.

Last year, our son Abraham married Cayly Norton. Damaris is pursuing a career in pharmacy. My wife, Nidia, has been a faithful supporter and helpmate in everything from preparing the studio and reading the Bible live, to praying and coordinating the program. As of December, she is retiring from

work in Chicago where she served 35 years. During the year, God granted us the privileges of visiting the promised land of Israel, so we are now better able to put the Bible and geography together.

On the other hand, I have kept up the ministry as police Bible study and prayer pastor and the street ministry of playing accordion. I am scheduled to continue teaching at Judson SEMS (Spanish English Ministries Studies) where I will be teaching, Evangelism, Mission, Worship and Theology Classes in Elgin and Chicago.

We leave for mission work in Chile in January 2022 and plan to return at the end of March. Please pray for my sister Ana Maria Fuentes who pastors the Covenant Church in Rancagua, Chile. She has cancer and needs our prayer support. Also, if you feel led, please support our ministry prayerfully and financially. I need new equipment to continue preaching the Good News--a sound system, speakers, microphone, a photocopy machine, and new phone. My goal for the next year is to continue doing God's Work according to Romans 15:6: “So that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.”
