### Governmental Issues

Just twenty days after the new Honduran president was sworn into office, the former president, John Orlando Hernández, was extradited by the United States government for charges relating to his participation in drug and arms trafficking into the United States. He is also facing several charges here in Honduras. This has generated a lot of protest from both his supporters and opponents.

### Homefront Housing

Recently, there was a temporary need for us to share our home with two families for two very different reasons.

A dear pastor friend from Nicaragua was part of a pastor's meeting during which they prayed for the Lord to bring changes to Nicaragua and its people. That was considered a defiance of the present government and each of those pastors were arrested or, as in the case of our friend, fled the country to avoid being arrested. Since then, his wife and their three young adult children have been with us.

As for the other family, the wife and three children fled domestic

violence. We are prayerful that the abusive husband will get treatment for his anger issues and, even greater, surrender his life to the Lord Jesus Christ.

### Focus on Education

At Manos Extendidas, we are excited and moving forward with the plans to sponsor ten young adults between the ages of eighteen and twenty-four with college classes for the next five years. Our board of directors shares that vision and has approved the decision to take these steps.

Their degrees will cover a variety of professions: teaching, engineering in computer systems, law, and medical services.

In Honduras, public school education is said to be free. However, students at every level must pay a quarterly or annual registration fee. Additionally, all books used in any class must be purchased by the student along with the provision of transportation to and from the facility.

Rosa, twenty, desires to become a lawyer. She has not begun classes because she is unable to afford them. In most cases, at Rosa's age, parents expect children to

work to ADD to the family's income, not to SUBTRACT from it. She, as well as most of our young people, will be studying at the most recognized public university in the country. Her yearly educational expenses will be just \$1,500.

Katherine is studying to become a nurse. Her yearly expenses will be \$2,300.00

Each of the students receiving assistance are totally devoted to the Lord, have grown up in our ministry and are serving there in some form or fashion.

Imagine that within the next five years, for \$60,000.00 (at present cost), we can effectively shape the future of Honduras through the education of ten godly citizens. WOW!!! I am excited folks!
